God Turns the Ordinary into Extraordinary

This is so clearly demonstrated in the story of Mary and Martha and their relationship with Jesus Christ (Luke 10:38-42). Martha was caught up with the business of life with no time to sit at the Master's feet

and glean from His teachings and leadership. So it is with many Christians today who is overcome by the mundane things in life that have no spiritual reward. As Christians we struggle to stay focused and develop the intimacy with God that He desires from us. From this paradigm, I drew the conclusion that I used to be like Martha, but I want to be like Mary! I want to be like Mary who trusted God enough to be used by Him. Do you want to be used by God? Do you trust God enough to let Him surprise you? You will be glad you did because His ways and His surprises are always filled with blessings. God did not chose Mary because of her education, wealth, nor her maturity. God chose her because she trusted him. Characteristics of A Godly Woman

Proverbs 31provides a detailed list of the characteristics of the godly woman. The godly woman is diligent, leads by example, and girded with wisdom and grace. She is called blessed and her husband praises her. Most importantly, she fears God and exhibits fidelity. She is peaceful and strong, a supporter and helper. Additionally, she is an encourager and reassures and reminds her husband by asserting what God has promised or commanded as we see in Judges 4 in the story of Deborah

who was a judge in Israel. She is a mother and she is focused and does not cause distractions. The godly woman is a leader who leads others into worship. She is influential and a woman of power and authority. The godly woman also has exemplary spiritual qualities as demonstrated by Mary the mother of Jesus (Luke 1:26-52; 2:19). The godly woman is humble and thankful; she is slow to talk because she is adorned with a meek and quiet spirit. She is not defensive and argumentative but she is meditative, patient and temperate—she is not rash and boisterous (John 2:3-5; Luke 2:48-51). The godly woman is prayerful and companied with people of like passion and faith. The godly woman is instructed by the Holy Spirit; she is a disciple of one—listening to the word of God and absorbed in the higher spiritual things that are eternal (Luke 10:39). The godly woman is submissive and maintains a posture of reverence. She remains calm in adversity and confident in trusting her master Jesus. I pray that as we meditate upon these Scriptures, our hearts will begin to turn towards the Master even more and we will experience extraordinary life changes that makes us into extraordinary women—poised to be used by God..

Changing Your Perspective

In the story of Mary the mother of Jesus (Luke 1:26-52), she could have seen her situation as a problem, but she chose to see it as a promise filled with all sorts of wonderful possibilities. We must change our perspective about our current status—acknowledging that there is nothing too hard for God. The next time you are tempted to be discouraged by the anxieties of life, remember you have a heavenly Father who says, "Nothing is impossible for me" (Phil 4:13).

Be encouraged. God has a custom made plan for you. His plan for our lives is not automatic but when you corporate with His purpose, He can use you beyond our greatest imagination. For example, He took Gideon from a farmer to a fighter (Judges 6); David from a shepherd to a king (1 Chron. 29:22); and Paul from a persecutor to a preacher (Acts 9). As a man thinketh in his heart, so is he (Prov.23:7). Change your perspective about yourself and God will fulfill His promise in your life.

Be resolved to make a change! Confess today that.."I used to be like Martha but I am striving to be like Mary".
